The Spencer Wright Bursary Application Form

Terms

The Spencer Wright Bursary is £200.00 grant, available to anyone undertaking a full time under graduate course in Theatre or Performance Arts.

The course must be principally to study Acting, Dance, Music or Technical theatre.

The grant can only be used to purchase tools and equipment relating directly to students of theatre. This includes books (including electronic), tools, craft items and training clothes. It does not include equipment relating to mobile phones, iPad, laptops, living or travel expenses, field trips or events. Please contact us for advice if you are unsure.

Applicants must be a minimum of 16 years old.

Only one application per student will be considered.

Payment will be made by electronic transfer.
